

3 BBB Student Ethics Scholarships Available

Better Business Bureau Serving Connecticut

This year, BBB Serving CT is offering three separate scholarships. The Student Ethics Scholarship, Military Line Student Ethics Scholarship, and Diverse Student Ethics Scholarship are each worth \$2,500. One applicant will be chosen from each category. Please read through the descriptions below and pick the most applicable.

Student Ethics Scholarship \$2,500

Eligibility

BBB's Student Ethics Scholarship recognizes college-bound high-school students who personify high ethics demonstrated through leadership, community service, overall integrity and academic standing.

For this scholarship, students must apply while in their senior year of high school. The winner will receive a scholarship to an accredited college or university of his or her choice.

The funds will be distributed directly to the school upon verification of the student's college enrollment. The scholarship must be applied toward school related expenses including: tuition, books, room and/or board, or other related items.

The applicant must be a resident of Connecticut.

Submission and deadline

Entries must be submitted <u>online</u> or via mail by February 1, 2023. CT Better Business Bureau Student Ethics Award 29 Berlin Road Cromwell. CT 06416

Entries for BBB Student Ethics Scholarship Award will be reviewed by the Selection Committee comprised of business leaders and members of the academic community. Judges will select the scholarship recipients based on their leadership, contributions to their communities and schools, personal integrity, academic accomplishments, and written essay. Decisions of the judges are final.

Military Line Student Ethics Scholarship \$2,500

Eligibility

BBB's Military Line Student Ethics Scholarship recognizes college-bound students and adult learners who are children or spouses of a military member. Eligible students should personify high ethics demonstrated through leadership, community service, overall integrity and academic standing.

For this scholarship, students and adult learners may apply as a senior in high school through the end of their college freshman year.

The winner will receive a scholarship to an accredited college or university of his or her choice.

The funds will be distributed directly to the school upon verification of the student's college enrollment. The scholarship must be applied toward school related expenses including: tuition, books, room and/or board, or other related items.

The applicant must be a resident of Connecticut.

Submission and deadline

Entries for BBB Student Ethics Scholarship Award will be reviewed by the Selection Committee comprised of business leaders and members of the academic community. Diverse Student Ethics Scholarship \$2,500

This scholarship is offered to a college-bound high school student who is a member of a diverse group. Diversity is defined by race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, or any other disenfranchised group.

Eligible students should personify high ethics demonstrated through leadership, community service, overall integrity, and academic standing. BBB's Diverse Student Ethics Scholarship is open to college-bound high school students of a diverse background.

For this scholarship, students must apply while in their senior year of high school.

The applicant must be a resident of Connecticut.

Submission and deadline
